Any boy or girl between the ages of 8 and 17 can take a free airplane ride through the EAA Young Eagles Program. This is an opportunity to experience the freedom of flight that many people only dream about. They'll fly with a local EAA volunteer pilot who will show them what real pilots do on the ground and in the air. Many people remember this experience for the rest of their lives - you will, too!

After the flight, the pilot will present each Young Eagle with their very own Young Eagles logbook with a unique code to receive a free EAA Student Membership, which unlocks even more opportunities and resources to participate in the exciting world of flight! Student members get free access to the Sporty's Pilot Shop Learn to Fly Course (a \$199 value), free admission to 300+ Science and Technology Museums, free student membership in the Academy of Model Aeronautics, an electronic copy of Sport Aviation (the EAA's monthly magazine), and much more.

The EAA Young Eagles program was launched in 1992 to give interested young people ages 8 to 17 the opportunity to go flying in a general aviation airplane. The volunteers who participate in the Young Eagles program are local members of EAA who are volunteering their time and aircraft to make your flight possible.
